Quick Review: The journey to breakthrough

- We must **<u>believe</u>** God is good for breakthrough to begin.
- We must "make room" for breakthrough by removing the idols in our lives.
- Fear keeps us from "stepping out" to unleash God's power into impossible situations.
- "Stepping out" requires courage; the power to act despite our fears.
- **Courage** demands <u>faith</u>; that God will do what He has promised.
- Faith is the result of seeing Jesus "up close" and for who He is.
- <u>**Prayer**</u> is God's <u>invitation</u> to see Jesus "up close" and believe He will do the impossible for you.
- <u>Fasting</u> is choosing to remove whatever <u>distracts</u> us from seeing and experiencing Jesus for who He is.
- <u>Absolutely Small</u> (size absolutely matters) only "in reverse," to birth and sustain breakthrough.
