How do we measure greatness?

Following Jesus into greatness

How to be authentically humble:

2. We achieve true greatness when we embrace Christ's "mindset" toward **power** and **possessions.**

⁶ who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,

 We become truly great when we embrace Christ's "mindset" toward position and prestige.

⁷ but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men.

4. We become truly great when we embrace Christ's "mindset" toward productivity.

5. We experience the ______ of true greatness when we follow Christ's example of **servanthood**.
