Discovering the “Unfiltered” Jesus in John 2

What does John Chapter 2 _____?

- Context: The first five disciples follow Him. John 1:35 – 51

- Structure: Two specific sections – the Wedding and the Whipping

- Observations: The Wedding John 2:1-11
 1. The host runs out of wine.
 2. Jesus’ mother requests help.
 3. Jesus instructs the servants, water supernaturally turns into wine.
 4. Only the disciples and servants are aware of a miracle.
 5. This miracle is Jesus’ first “sign.”
 6. The disciples see Jesus in a new light and believe.

- Observations: The Whipping John 2: 12-25
 1. Jesus goes to the Passover Feast in Jerusalem.
 2. Jesus drives out animals and money changers.
 3. Jesus calls the Temple His Father’s house.
 4. Jesus’ authority is challenged by the Pharisees.
 5. Jesus performs many miracles.
 6. Many people believe on His name.
 7. Jesus knows men’s hearts.

 - Religious leaders?
 - His disciples?
 - The multitudes?
