- John 1:35 51
- Structure: Two specific sections the <u>Wedding</u> and the <u>Whipping</u>
- Observations: The Wedding

John 2:1-11

- 1. The host runs out of wine.
- 2. Jesus' mother requests help.
- 3. Jesus instructs the servants, water supernaturally turns into wine.
- 4. Only the disciples and servants are aware of a miracle.
- 5. This miracle is Jesus' first "sign."
- 6. The disciples see Jesus in a new light and believe.

John 2: 12-25

- 1. Jesus goes to the Passover Feast in Jerusalem.
- 2. Jesus drives out animals and money changers.
- 3. Jesus calls the Temple His Father's house.
- 4. Jesus' authority is challenged by the Pharisees.
- 5. Jesus performs many miracles.
- 6. Many people believe on His name.
- 7. Jesus knows men's hearts.
