### Five elements in the parable of the sower

Matthew 13, Mark 4, Luke 8

- **1. Sower** (teacher) = Son of Man Moral and spiritual authority, and power given by the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Seed (message) = The Word → Truth → Gospel (Mat. 4:4, Heb. 4:12) (Jn. 17:17) (Rom. 1:16)
- **3. Soil** (hearers) = Human heart's responses to truth

- **4. Growth** (response) = 1<sup>st</sup> soil, 2<sup>nd</sup> soil, 3<sup>rd</sup> soil, 4<sup>th</sup> soil

  None Immediate Significant Supportive = 30, 60, 100
- 5. Fruit (desired outcome) =  $1^{st}$  soil,  $2^{nd}$  soil,  $3^{rd}$  soil,  $4^{th}$  soil

  None None None Much fruit

#### Ten observations:

- 1. Family relationship with Jesus is doing God's will.
- 2. God's will is that we follow Jesus.
- 3. The sower of God's Word is the Son of Man.
- 4. The seed is God's Word.
- 5. The soils are the conditions of the heart responses to the truth.
- 6. Effective sowing, teaching, and preaching, are essential, but we must cultivate and prepare the soil for it to have an impact.
- 7. Growth and fruit are not synonymous.
- 8. Fruitfulness, mature disciples who do God's will, is the goal of preaching and teaching.
- 9. God has given us the raw material of His Word, the Holy Spirit, and one another to actually produce fruitfulness.
- 10. Only God can make the seed grow.
