Introduction: A powerful proclamation "Then" and "Now"

- ²⁷ Jesus and His disciples went on to the villages around Caesarea Philippi. On the way He asked them, "Who do people say I am?"
- ²⁸ They replied, "Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, one of the prophets."
- ²⁹ "But what about you?" He asked. "Who do you say I am?" Peter answered, "You are the Christ."
- ³⁰ Jesus warned them not to tell anyone about Him.

Mark 8:27-30 (NIV)

 Peter's confession was based on less than 3 years of observation, teaching, and living with Jesus.

 How would John answer this question some 60 years later to strengthen a persecuted church, where Jesus' identity and their lives were under attack?
